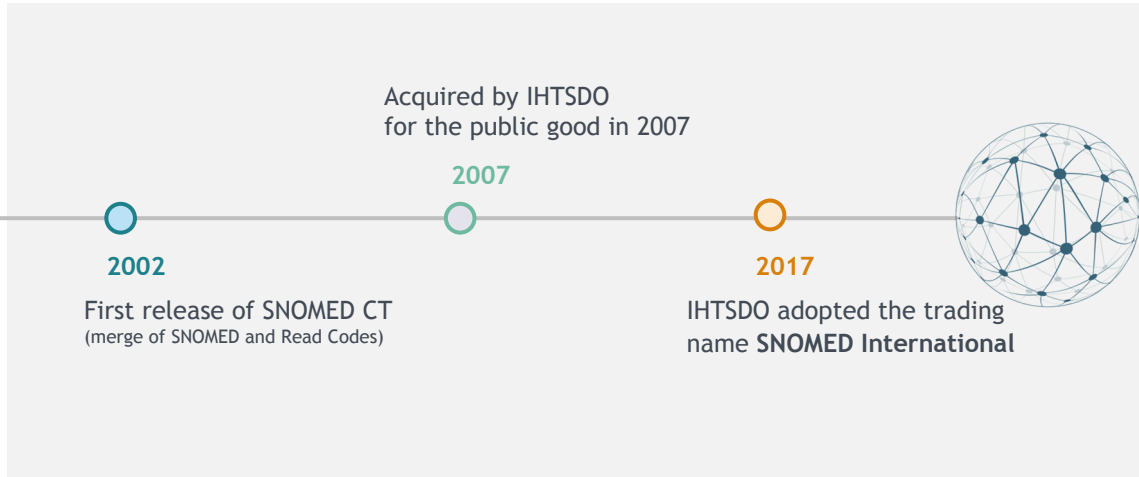

Timeliness:

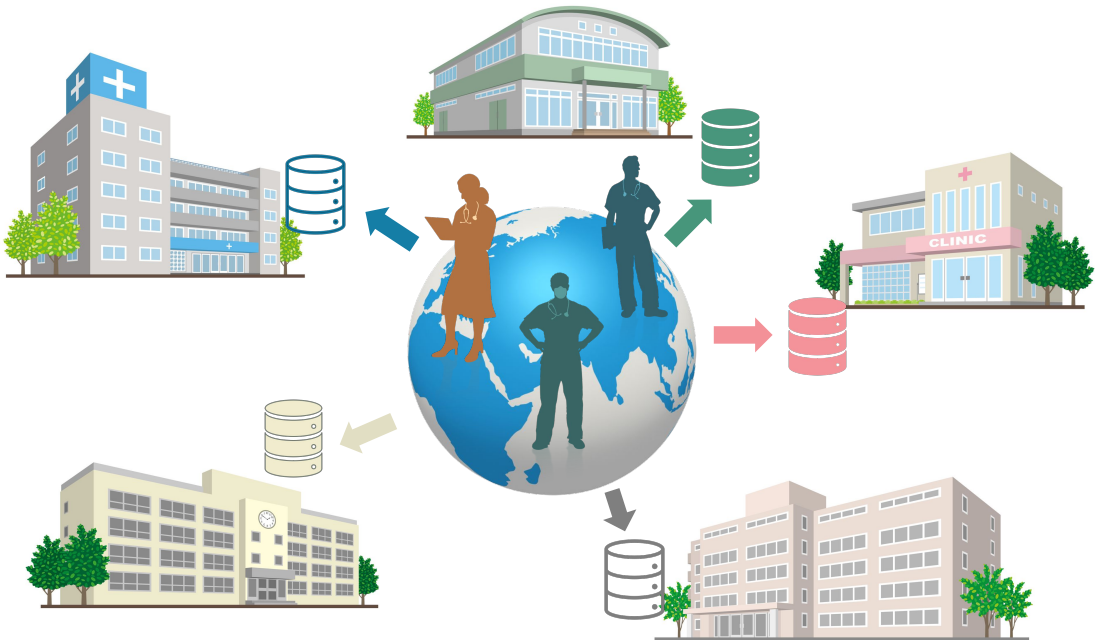

We want to be able to use data to support **clinical research** and **decision making**



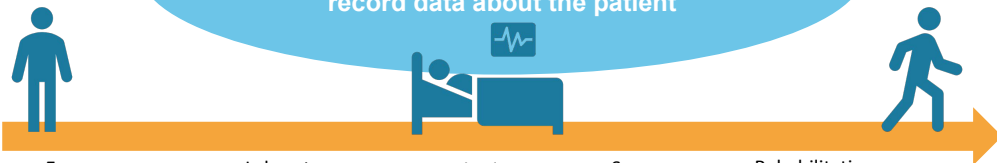
We want to record clinical details using a **clinically-focused language**

We need a **standardized** way to **collate data** about diseases and mortality in our country

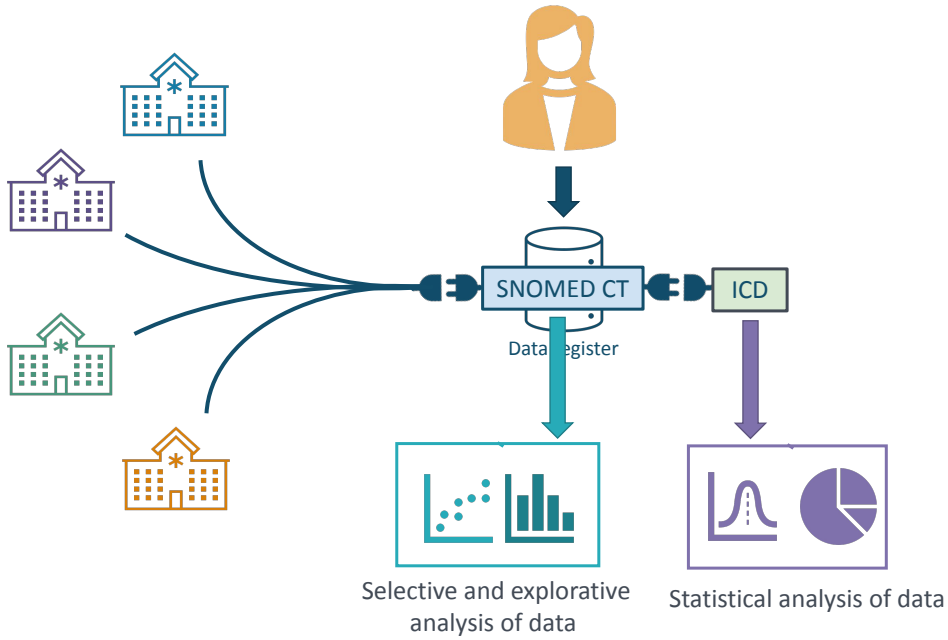
