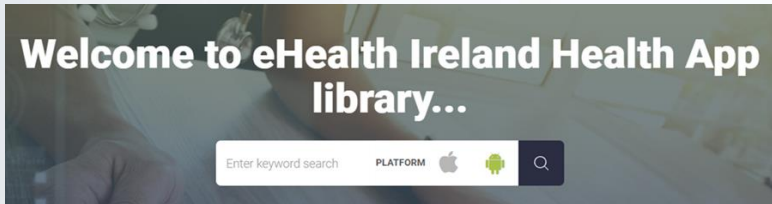

- Health bodies, entrepreneurs and researchers showcasing innovative solutions

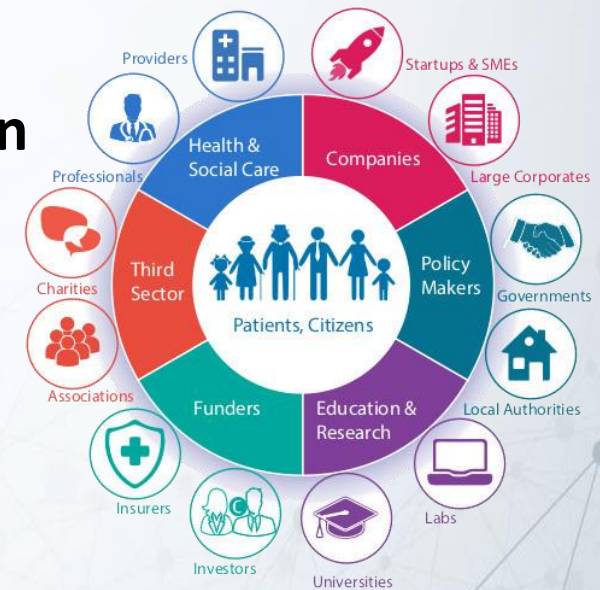

- Harnessing digital innovation to ensure that fewer Irish citizens develop avoidable complications of diabetes

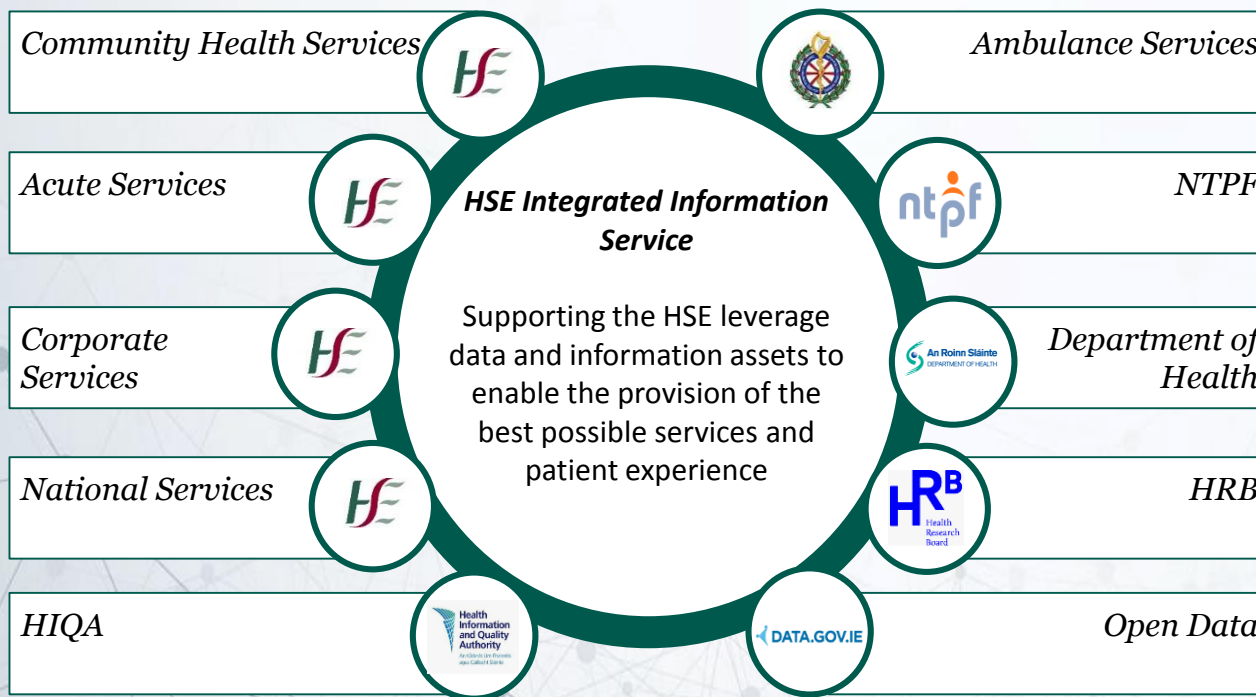


Integrated Information Services

A central capability providing information services across the HSE



Conceptually, the IIS is a centralised service that creates and maintains policies, standards and governance around the HSE's data; leverages a common platform to produce timely, meaningful insights; automates mandatory reports and provides capability to users to maximise the value they achieve from their data to drive improvements.



4 core objectives of the IIS:

1. Enhance insights to drive better decision making and sustainably improve the quality of care
2. Consolidate information to provide a comprehensive understanding of the entirety of the health system
3. Create the necessary data governance standards and oversight to streamline access and adequately manage quality of information
4. Create the organisational structures and processes required to transform information services provided in the HSE

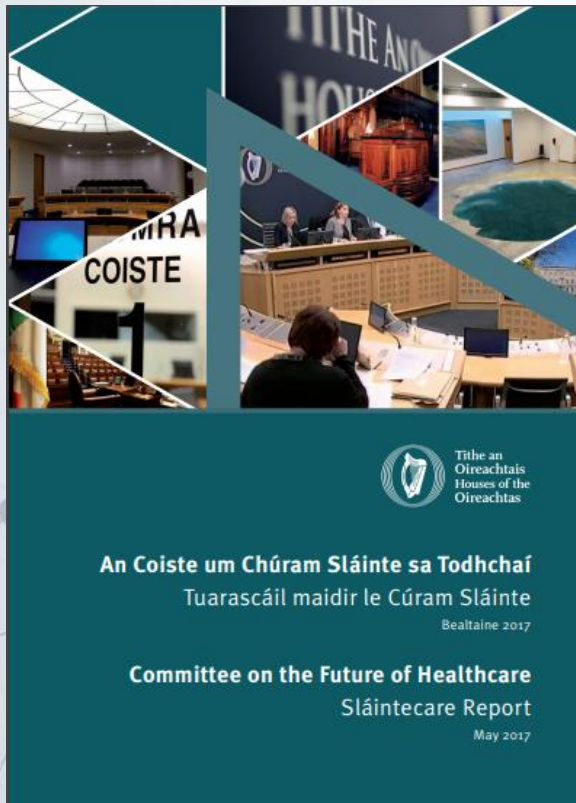
