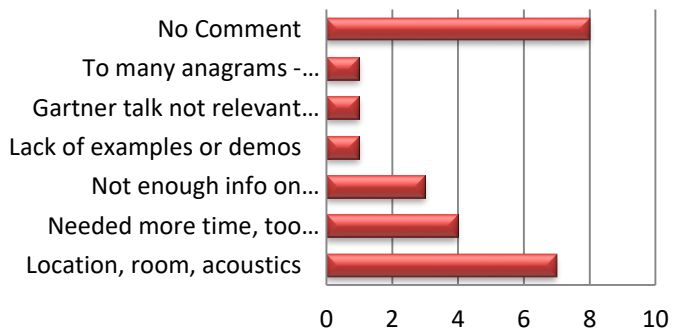

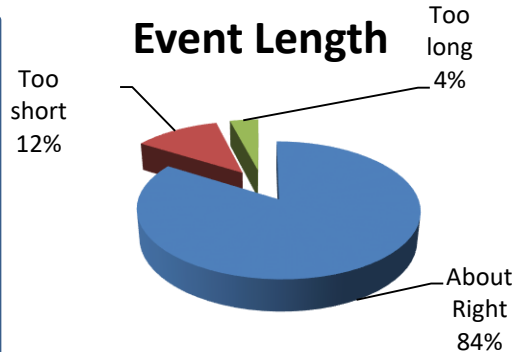
What people liked ...



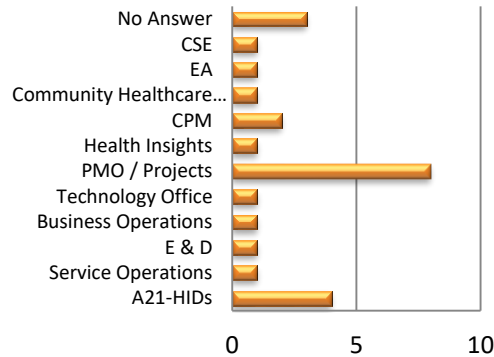
What people disliked ...



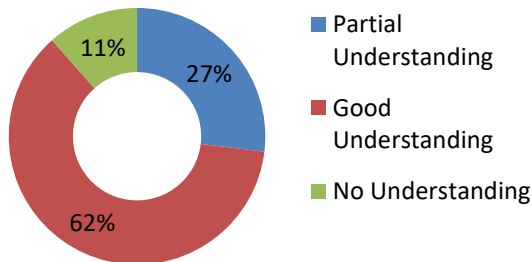

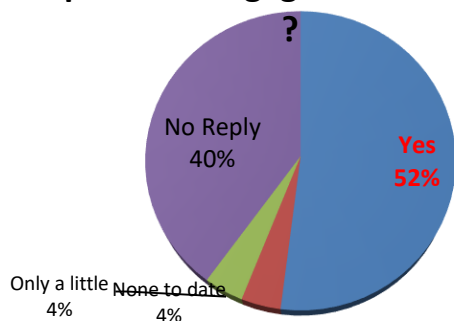
